

Webelos Troop 372 Campout  
November 11-13, 2011  
Camp Buffalo, north of Monticello

Troop 372, which meets at Christ United Methodist Church, would like to invite the Webelos from Pack 3371 to go camping. This is an opportunity to get to know the boys in Troop 372, and the Troop itself. This is “easy camping”; no tents are needed, as we will actually be staying in the Ivy Lodge. Activities will include fire building, first aid, hiking, team building activities and more. This trip is aimed at the second-year boys, but first-year boys are welcome too.

**Cost:** \$15/person (scout or adult). If paying by check, make your check payable to “Troop 372”, not “Pack 3371”. ☺

**Logistic details:**

We will rendezvous at 6:15 PM at the north side of the Home Depot parking lot on Friday, November 11<sup>th</sup>, and we will leave that location promptly at 6:30 PM. Feel free to arrange carpooling. Maps, directions, and permission slips will be provided at the rendezvous. We will return to the same location at 12 noon on Sunday, November 13<sup>th</sup>. Please eat dinner before joining us on Friday, as we will have only a light snack that evening.

**Registration:**

If you want to go, you must sign up by November 9<sup>th</sup>, so that the Troop knows how much food to get. Registration is easy; just tell Mr. Rattray the name of the attending boy and attending parent or other relative. Payment can be made at the rendezvous.

**Things to bring**

- Hiking boots/tennis shoes (more than one pair is recommended)
- Warm clothes for the weekend
- Warm hat; i.e. knit cap
- Sweatshirt or jacket or coat
- Rain gear
- Sleeping bag and pad
- Small Pillow
- Toiletries
- Compass
- Flashlight and extra batteries
- Personal First Aid kit
- Watch
- Webelos Handbook
- BSA Medical form, parts A and C, if you haven't submitted one yet.
- “Gold Sheets” from Midway, if you haven't gone over them with a leader yet.

Since we will not be backpacking, it is easiest to pack your stuff in totes. The troop has an equipment trailer that will take all of our gear all the way to the lodge. Note that we may have to hike part of that distance, so please make sure your stuff goes in the trailer!
